Dr. Suzanne Slonim is the Founder and Medical Director of the Fibroid Institute Dallas. She is the only Interventional Radiologist in the region who focuses solely on treating fibroids with Uterine Fibroid Embolization (UFE). She created the Fibroid Institute in direct response to her belief that UFE should be more accessible to all patients.

Dr. Slonim graduated from George Washington University School of Medicine and completed her internship at UCLA, residency at the Lahey Clinic Medical Center, and fellowship at Stanford University Medical Center, where she went on to practice on staff for five years. Dr. Slonim has authored over 20 publications and most recently authored the book *Pain-Free Periods: Banish Menstrual Misery, Fight Fibroids and Get Your Life Back* to help women better understand their bodies, their symptoms from fibroids, and the different ways to treat them. She has performed over 30,000 procedures and is widely regarded as a leading expert in UFE procedures.

A pioneer in her profession, Dr. Slonim served as the first female medical staff President at Methodist Dallas Medical Center, where she also served as Medical Director of Interventional Radiology for 15 years. Prior to launching The Fibroid Institute Dallas, she was a Partner and President of Radiology Consultants Association (RCA), a large private practice radiology group.

Dr. Slonim focuses on an issue unique to women, to empower them to improve the quality of their lives. Through her practice, Dr. Slonim also serves the disadvantaged in providing pro-bono medical services to under-resourced patients. She extends flexibility in self-pay and insurance supplemented procedures, making it possible for patients to absorb the out-of-pocket costs in a way that makes it possible for them to afford. Dr. Slonim works to fulfill her life's mission of helping women who suffer from uterine fibroids to improve and eliminate their symptoms without surgery.

Her honors include being named for multiple years to the D Magazine "Best Doctor" and "Texas Super Doctor" lists, being a Fellow of the Society of Interventional Radiology and the American College of Radiology, and being a 2020 honoree for the Dallas Business Journal Women in Business Award.
