Dr. Slonim's focus is Uterine Fibroid Embolization (UFE), a minimally invasive procedure that blocks blood supply to the fibroids and avoids the removal of the uterus. By performing UFE in an outpatient setting, Dr. Slonim is fulfilling her passion for helping women live fibroid free without major surgery.

Dr. Slonim is board certified in radiology as well as vascular and interventional radiology. She received her education and training from several prestigious universities, including George Washington University School of Medicine, UCLA, and Stanford University.

She completed her residency training in diagnostic radiology at The Lahey Clinic in Boston, then went on to become fellowship trained in interventional radiology at Stanford University in Palo Alto, California.

Dr. Slonim remained on staff at Stanford for five years. While there, she published many scientific articles in peer-reviewed journals, presented research findings at national meetings, and trained residents and fellows in interventional radiology.

In 2000, Dr. Slonim moved to Dallas. She was honored with fellowship in the Society of Interventional Radiology in 2012 and fellowship in the American College of Radiology in 2013.

Before founding Fibroid Institute Dallas, Dr. Slonim was the first woman to serve as medical staff president at Methodist Dallas Medical Center. She was also a partner and president of Radiology Consultants Association. She has become a leader in the field of interventional radiology, specializing in treating uterine fibroids.
